The John Bergeron Summer Research Scholarship provides an Anatomy and Cell Biology undergraduate student (U1-U3) the opportunity to conduct a 12-week paid summer research project with a professor in the department. At the end of the summer, the student is encouraged to present their results in a lab meeting, and participate in the Undergraduate Research Conference.

Applications are reviewed and evaluated by a selection committee of professors. Previous recipients of the scholarship are NOT eligible to apply. **Your application must be sent to macss.presidents@gmail.com by 11:59 pm on Sunday, March 10th, 2019 to be considered.**

- Learn proper laboratory techniques and how to troubleshoot
- Develop critical thinking skills in experimental design and interpretation
- Practice communication results in a clear and effective manner
- Discover what it takes to be a scientific researcher

STUDENT STIPEND:

- \$2000 from the McGill Anatomy and Cell Biology Student Society (MACSS)
- At least \$2000 from the departmental supervisor

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Minimum B+ (3.3 cGPA) average

- 200-word research proposal, including name of Anatomy and Cell Biology supervisor
- 1-page Statement of Purpose, demonstrating an interest in cell biology research
 - Previous research/relevant work experience
 - Describe research interests
 - Academic/professional goals
- Transcript
- CV
